Networking Day Basics

- **Step 1:** In your email, look for a message with “EECS Virtual Networking Day” in the title to find the link to the main session
- **Step 2:** Navigate, in order, to the sessions you signed up for after the main session ends (starting with 1, then 2, then 3, and lastly 4)
 - *if no one is in your session, wait for a moment and they will join*

Tips for Networking Day

- **Tip 1:** The main session stays open throughout the individual sessions
- **Tip 2:** Start at the main session, then once the individual sessions begin, feel free come back to ask questions and get help finding links to other sessions
- **Tip 3:** Review the information in the virtual booths

Do's and Don'ts of Zoom

- **Do** have your camera on with a virtual background (photo) or blurred background
- **Do** wear business casual clothes (Clean shirt/sweater/pants)
- **Do** arrive on time with relevant questions for the presenters
- **Treat this like a first-time business meeting**

- **Don't** be lying in bed
- **Don't** have unprofessional items behind you (alcohol, trash, etc.)
- **Be respectful**

How to Navigate to a Zoom Session

- **First**, look in your email for the session link. Click on it to open the session.
- **Second**, if you can't find the email with the link, go to the main session and check the shortened links that will be shared on screen. You can then type the link you are looking for into the browser.
- **Lastly**, if you need another option you can ask for the session link you are looking for in the main session chat.
